How To Find Us

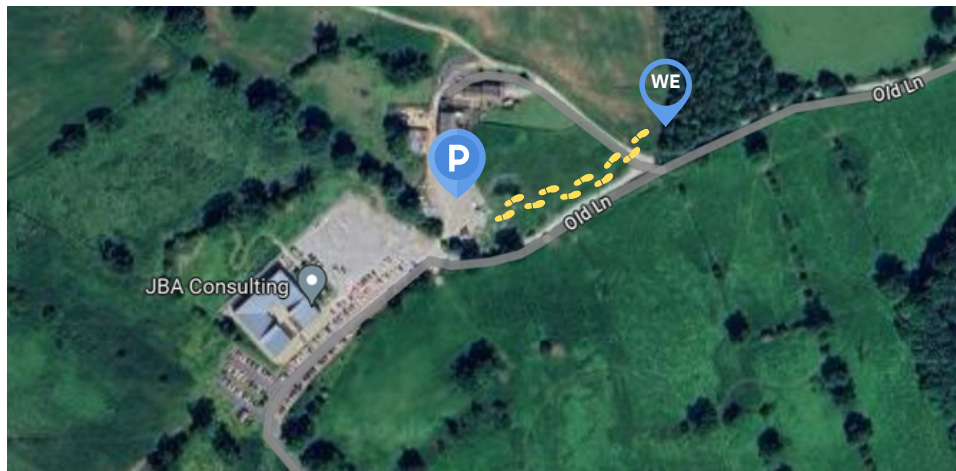
If travelling from Skipton towards Broughton Hall along the A59, you will pass The Bull pub on the left hand side. Opposite The Bull (on your right) is Gargrave Road, signposted Gargrave. Turn right onto Gargrave Road.

After passing a row of cottages on your left then a row of cottages on your right, you will see an unmarked tarmacked road on your left just before the road bends round to the right, this is Old Lane. Turn left down Old Lane and follow the road around. Pass the woodland on your right and keep going until you see the carpark ahead. Our car park is the smaller one of the two located here.

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On foot, follow the signposted, mown path across the field to get to the woodland entrance. Please do not walk along the road as this makes it dangerous for the children & other drivers.

Our Expectations

Wild Explorers adopt a child-led, fun and nurturing approach. Children can choose how they spend their day, what activities they engage with and what time they eat.

We do however have a loose rhythm to our days. Children will be invited to have a mid-morning snack (brought from home) at around 10:30am and we will break for lunch at around 12pm. We will then have an afternoon snack (provided by Wild Explorers) around 2:30pm. There will be a number of activities provided throughout the day that the children can choose to take part in (or not!) as well as lots of free play.

We kindly ask that you support us by leaving the premises promptly. If your child displays any signs of illness throughout the holiday club day, we may require immediate pick up. Please let us know your location and expected time of arrival; we will have your child and their belongings ready for when you arrive. We will ask for your expected time of arrival so we can reassure your child and minimise any anxieties.

Please be aware that hygiene and cleanliness are our priority, handwashing will be done frequently throughout the day as well as the usual times, before eating etc. The toilet will be cleaned at regular intervals throughout the day.

A Note About Risk

As an outdoor facility in a woodland setting, there are additional risks associated with our activities. We make every effort to ensure the provision is as safe as possible and that the benefits of any activities are balanced with the potential risks. Children are appropriately informed of the boundaries of play at the beginning of each session & reminded of these boundaries when necessary.

To support us with this, we ask that you ensure your children are sent wearing appropriate clothing and sturdy footwear, and that you tell us about any medical or behavioural information which may impact your child and our interactions with them.
